

Nature & Wildlife



01. Ruma National Park

Home to unique wildlife like the Roan Antelope and Rothschild's Giraffe. This park is home to game that delivers an authentic safari experience.

02. Gwassi Hills Forest Reserves

This area offers hiking trails, birdwatching and panoramic views of Lake Victoria. If relaxing in nature is your thing, this is the place to be.

03. Lake Simbi

A crater lake with a unique ecosystem. It is famed for the beautiful flamingos that inhabit the lake. Its waters are also fabled for their healing properties.

04. Takawiri Island

Known for its beaches and resorts. You can go and have a relaxing day in what will feel like paradise on a very reasonable budget.





History & Culture



01. Tom Mboya Mausoleum

A tribute to the Kenyan politician, offering historical insights. Tom Mboya was a champion of workers rights and a proud son of Homa Bay.

02. Mfangano Island


This island is known for its ancient rock art sites believed to be between 1,000 and 4,000 years old as you explore the caves and rock shelters there.

03. Local Villages

Experience Luo culture and traditions as you visit a traditional village setting where communities still retain their love for building grass thatched houses.

04. Abasuba Peace Museum

Located on Mfangano Island, this museum preserves the cultural heritage and promotes peace among the Abasuba community.







Culture & Spiritual



01. Homa Hills

Known for its unique geological formations, including rare carbonate lava, and also offer opportunities for hiking and enjoying the natural scenery.

02. Mawanga & Kwitone Rock Art

Found on Mfangano Island these locations feature ancient rock art sites with various shapes believed to be related to rainmaking and healing rituals.

03. Bala Hot Spring

Known for medicinal powers and folklore, is a natural marvel where geysers burst with steam, a truly authentic Homa Bay experience.

04. Abururu Waterfalls

These waters cascade where the Awach River splits into three, surrounded by rich bird life. A very unique experience for avian enthusiasts.
